Discipline Policy

Children of Mini Melodies will be disciplined in a form of teaching opposed to a form of punishment. We want all children to learn how to get along with others and stay safe. We want to teach them to be respectful of all people. We will on a daily basis enforce key lessons such as sharing, patience, cooperation, respect, and caution. We will reinforce these lessons with consistency, patience, and compassion. It will take some time to sink in, for some children, and others will learn faster, but consistency is key.

When children misbehave, they will be given a firm warning in which I will discuss with them their behavior and consequences. I will make sure it is understood why there would be consequences if such actions are repeated. Warnings will be given according to their behavior and age. If the behavior is repeated, I will continue to work with their behavior using redirection, quiet time with quiet activity. Time-outs will be the last resource. The length of the time-out is a minute per age. Redirection will be used for children under two years of age.

If things progress, then I will meet with the parents to resolve the situation.
